Orient Green Power Limited



- OGPL is a key renewables-based power generator and focuses mainly on wind- and biomass-based generation.
- In July 2011, Beta Wind Farms Limited, a subsidiary of OGPL, synchronised an 18.7 MW wind project at Gudimangalam in Tiruppur, Tamil Nadu. With this, OGPL's installed wind capacity in the state increased to 172 MW. In the same month, the company commissioned a Rs 550 million, 10 MW biomass-based power plant at Pollachi in Tamil Nadu. The project, which predominantly uses coconut fronds for power generation, is a first-of-its-kind facility in India and the state's first IPP based on the concept of distributed power.
- In September 2011, Beta Wind Farms synchronised a 40.8 MW wind farm with Tamil Nadu's state grid. The project is located at Kazugumulai in Tirunelveli district. OGPL has also commissioned a 10.5 MW wind farm in Croatia through its subsidiary Orient Green Power Europe. With this, the company's total renewables-based installed capacity has crossed 300 MW, comprising 250 MW of wind power and 50 MW of biomass-based projects. So far, OGPL has added 80 MW in 2011-12 and plans to commission another 147 MW by March 2012.
